**SPECIAL TOPIC: Principal Lancaster discusses Bogan's State Report Card / Achievement Testing.**

- Beginning April 21, Students in grades 3, 4, 5 will participate in Ohio Student Achievement Testing.
- Third grade will test in Reading and Math.
- Fourth grade will test in Reading, Math, and Writing
- Fifth grade will test in Reading, Math, Science, and Social Studies.
- Schools are required to meet indicators or benchmarks showing that Students are proficient in the areas in which they are tested.
- Schools also have to show that Students have made "Adequate Yearly Progress" in the areas in which they are tested.
- These scores determine whether a school is designated as Excellent, Effective, Watch, or Academic Emergency.
- In 2006-2007 Bogan earned an Effective rating. TSD is also rated as Effective.
- The goal is for TSD and Bogan to be designated as Excellent this year.
- A letter was mailed home providing parents with a web page address and password . This site will provide parents with resource materials, as well as games and practice tests to assist Students in preparing for the state testing. If you did not receive a letter, please contact Mrs. Lancaster.
- There is a reference book available for check out in the Library that may help parents who may need instruction or assistance in regards to Talawanda's Math Program.
